EVALUATION AND CERTIFICATION



Before enrolling in the Center for Intensive Language Teaching program, all new learners must take a placement test. This test determines the level at which the student will be placed before the start of the training sessions.

At the end of the training session, the center issues level certificates based on the successful completion of the final exam. This certificate bears the label of Djilali Bounaama University in Khémis Miliana and mentions the candidate's scores in the four assessed skills according to the following scale:

- Oral Comprehension: 25 points
- Written Comprehension: 25 points
- Oral Production: 25 points
- Written Production: 25 points

The final grade is out of 100, and the passing grade starts from 50 out of 100.

As for learners who do not reach the required level, they will receive a certificate of participation.
